Our company, RapidSOS Inc., endorses and supports the efforts of the New York Mobile Integrated Healthcare Association. Specifically, we support the Association's model of improved out-of-hospital care including all efforts to make emergency medical services (EMS) more efficient using modern technology.

At RapidSOS, we believe community paramedicine will be a larger role in patient care and is essential in improving patient experience and the health of the population. We have developed an emergency technology platform that transmits multimedia content from the scene to 9-1-1 Public Safety Answering Points. We are convinced that our technology will allow dispatchers to make more efficient decisions on to which resources to dispatch.
